2. SCALBY LANE FLOOD PREVENTION

- To agree a process for ascertaining and damage: pre-start survey including photographs: ensure al contractors liaise with landowners. To re-instate as-is but not betterment.
- Anything liable to damage but recoverable to be removed first so it can be re-used.
- Cap on damages – fencing/slabs.
- Funding for re-instatement from borrowing costs. Project funds used not the parish council precept.
- Skitam Lodge has bridges over the dykes - so must include costs in reparations for the reinstatement of a bridge. Both existing bridges are rotten.

Agreed that parish council is committed to reparation costs but not betterment (ie as-is).
Recommended that LOID Board Mr E Allen be used as an independent witness.

All replacement materials provided by the parish council. Commission MASON CLARK to do initial survey and photographic record. Three quotes for the work to be done.

MASON CLARK to be contacted to arrange a pre-start survey.

Resolved.

3. 20 mph SCHEME

Mr P Robinson gave a short report – majority of the residents in favour of 20mph but no speed bumps with the 20mph and existing speed limits to be policed.

364 replies to ERYC survey – 80% in favour

Resolved to accept the 20 mph zone.

Mr P Robinson as Ward Councillor has asked for feasibility of a restricted waiting period outside the school: ie – no parking in front of the school 8.30am to 9.30am and 3pm to 4pm during term times.

An alternative proposed by a resident for zig-zag lines outside the school meaning no parking at any time was not supported by residents affected.

The parish council supports the proposal that ERYC be asked to do the feasibility for the restricted waiting period – ‘peak hours waiting restriction’.

Pelican crossing – Mr P Robinson has already requested a pelican crossing to be considered.

There being no further business the meeting closed at 7.20pm.
